- SALS (Southern Adirondack Library System) update: Schenectedy County Public Libraries (SCPL) are withdrawing from Joint Automation. This means SALS will no longer be able to get books through ILL from those libraries. That change was effective August 31, and patrons have until the end of December to return any books they have from SCPL (the books can be returned through ILL).
